Preparation for Worship

As we move through Holy Week, we are confronted with varied images: shouting "Hosanna," to welcome Christ into Jerusalem; gathering with close friends around our Lord's Table; hearing Jesus' call to eat and drink in remembrance of him; watching the disciples fall asleep; seeing Judas' betrayal of Christ; shouting "Crucify him! Crucify him!" and seeing Jesus dead on the cross. As we turn, gather in worship, each of us is invited to reflect on our betrayal of Christ and our hope in Christ.

Listen to me, O coastlands,
pay attention, you peoples from far away!
The Lord called me before I was born,
while I was in my mother's womb he named
me.

² He made my mouth like a sharp sword, in the shadow of his hand he hid me; he made me a polished arrow, in his quiver he hid me away.

- ³ And he said to me, "You are my servant, Israel, in whom I will be glorified."
- ⁴ But I said, "I have labored in vain,
 I have spent my strength for nothing and vanity;

yet surely my cause is with the Lord, and my reward with my God."

⁵ And now the Lord says, who formed me in the womb to be his servant, to bring Jacob back to him, and that Israel might be gathered to him, for I am honored in the sight of the Lord, and my God has become my strength— 6 he says,

"It is too light a thing that you should be my servant

to raise up the tribes of Jacob and to restore the survivors of Israel; I will give you as a light to the nations, that my salvation may reach to the end of the earth."

⁷ Thus says the Lord, the Redeemer of Israel and his Holy One, to one deeply despised, abhorred by the nations, the slave of rulers,

"Kings shall see and stand up, princes, and they shall prostrate themselves, because of the Lord, who is faithful, the Holy One of Israel, who has chosen you."
